A LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Friends,

Every few years, the Indiana 4-H Foundation, like so many other businesses, organizations and communities, spends time reviewing and evaluating its mission, purpose and focus. Who are we as an organization? What do we stand for? What efforts do we support?

After asking all of these questions and more of both ourselves and key partners across the state, one overriding fact became apparent: The Foundation always has, and should continue to, provide resources that give the opportunity for all Indiana youth to develop life skills that benefit their communities.

With that fact established, the Foundation began the process of creating a three year strategic plan. With input from many key stakeholders, we were able to re-double our focus to provide statewide youth development program funding for Indiana 4-H.

In 2014 we saw a huge benefit from our long-term corporate partnerships. Through Dow AgroSciences and with a grant from the Dow Chemical Foundation, Indiana 4-H was able to hire Erika Bonnett as the 4-H Youth Development Science Extension Specialist to help oversee and coordinate Indiana 4-H science programs and projects benefiting youth in all 92 counties. The Indiana Soybean Alliance partnered with the Indiana 4-H Foundation for the second year to fund “Teens Teaching Teens Biotechnology” workshops and ADM Cares supported the purchase of robotics kits. Indiana Farm Bureau stepped up to the plate once more to challenge our donors to match their contributions and because of their support we were able once again to nearly triple our \$50,000 Challenge.

Without the support of individual donors, we would not be able to create these corporate partnerships, grow Indiana 4-H programs and provide resources that give the opportunity for all Indiana youth to develop life skills that benefit their communities.

Consider the impact of the very special estate gift from Barbara J. Faris, who was never a member of 4-H, but was a supporter of her local program. And the impact on Indiana 4-H youth for years to come with an endowed scholarship like the one established by Bob and Maurine Anderson this year.

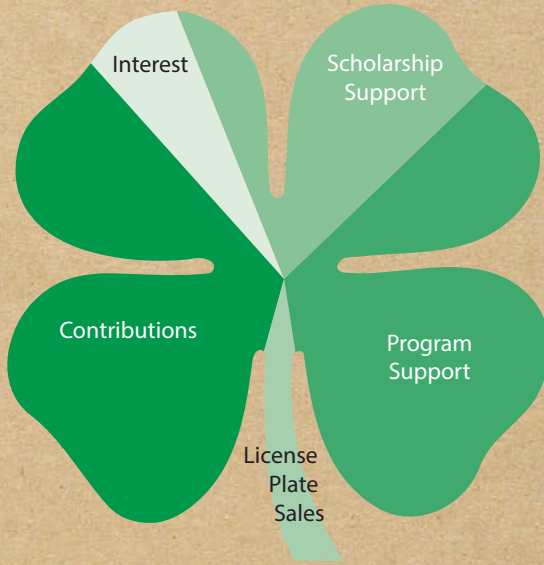

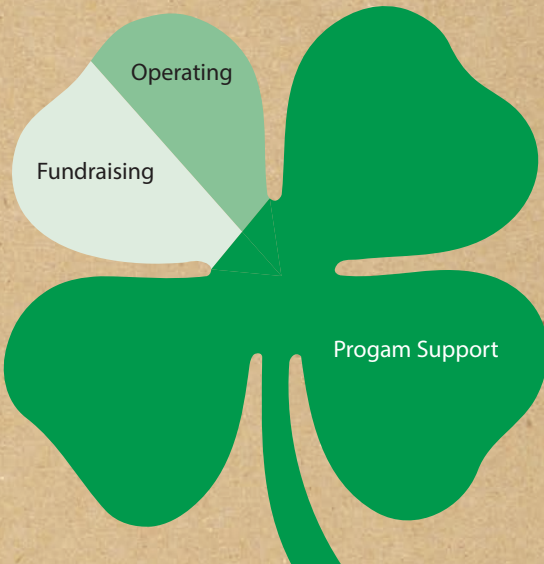

DOW CHEMICAL FOUNDATION SUPPORTS STATE SCIENCE EXTENSION SPECIALIST

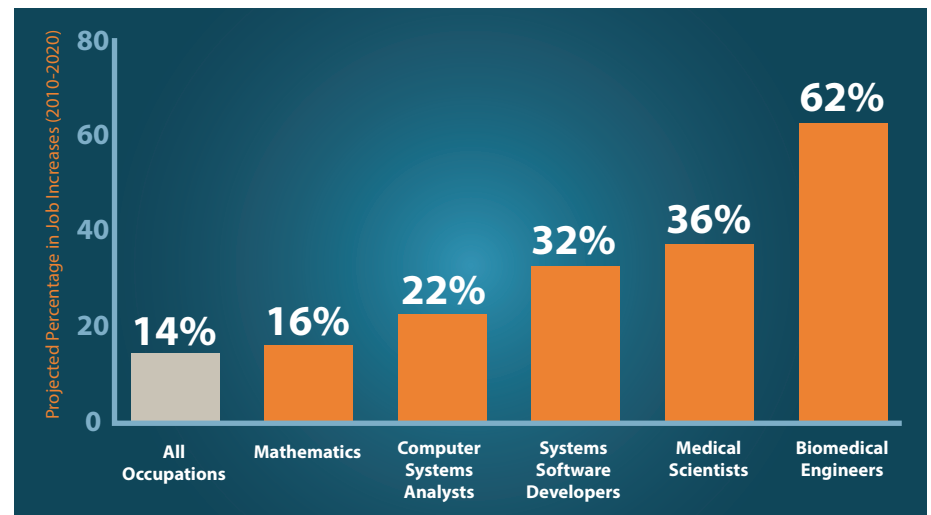


Erika Bonnett, Extension 4-H Youth Development Educator and County Extension Director in Bartholomew County moved into the position of 4-H Youth Development Science Extension Specialist

with the State 4-H Office in August 2014. This position is being generously funded with a gift from the Dow Chemical Foundation and the Indiana 4-H Foundation. Erika joined Purdue Extension in July, 2009 and under her leadership Bartholomew County's 4-H Program experienced exponential growth. She served as a member of the 4-H Science Mission Team and developed a significant footprint with her efforts regarding the creative implementation of robotics programming and 4-H biotechnology teams. Erika completed a B.S. degree in Agriculture and Environmental Education from West Virginia University and completed her M.S. in Agriculture Education at Texas A & M University. She also has prior 4-H Experience as an Extension Agent-Urban Youth Development with Texas Cooperative Extension and as an Extension Agent with Virginia Cooperative Extension.

We look forward to having Erika continue to evaluate and move forward 4-H Science initiatives. Erika will work closely with the Indiana 4-H Science Mission Team and with her leadership, Erika will build networks with faculty across campus, industry representatives and with new 4-H science volunteers as we build new opportunities for 4-H members.

ADM CARES SUPPORTS INDIANA 4-H ROBOTICS



ADM Cares provided funding to purchase robotics kits for Indiana 4-H. ADM Cares understands that through Indiana 4-H Robotics programs youth develop decision making and critical thinking skills and implement an understanding of the scientific and engineering design processes as they build real and virtual robots. As they work with

4-H adult volunteers (who serve as role models) they advance through the program and move from exploring robotic arms to the more complex aspects of engineering design.

In addition to increased understanding of basic and advanced robotics concepts, youth move into further learning and understanding with the use of commercial robotics kits to master robotics challenges and also to explore potential careers where engineering and technical skills are relevant. While one of the newest “science” areas to be introduced to 4-H members, this is also one of the most expensive to support due to the cost of the materials required to build and program the robots.

Indiana 4-H robotics programs work to increase the number and quality of science, engineering, technology and math programs that Indiana 4-H offers. Indiana 4-H Science initiatives increase science interest and literacy among youth, to increase the number of youth pursuing education in science, and to increase the number of youth pursuing science careers.



INDIANA SOYBEAN ALLIANCE SUPPORTS BIOTECHNOLOGY

The Indiana Soybean Alliance provided support for “Teens Teaching Teens Biotechnology.” Forty teens and fourteen adults representing eleven counties were trained to provide teen led science programs to teach upper elementary and middle school youth about biotechnology and how the science of agriculture is something that they interact with each day. Teens and adults were trained in communication/teaching techniques, hands-on biotechnology experiments, and how to relate to youth audiences.

Components of training teens to teach youth include: developing team cohesion, ages and stages of youth development, the experiential learning model, understanding different learning styles, helping teens appropriately process and reflect with the youth they are teaching, and all while having fun. To allow the teens an opportunity to practice teaching, there was time for ‘peer teaching’.

In addition to providing an introduction to AgriScience/Biotechnology, youth learned concepts such as Agricultural Literacy, Global Food Security, Sustainability, and about the variety of career paths associated with modern agriculture. Teams consisted of at least one adult and 3-5 teens (ages 14-16) that spent 15-20 hours being trained in hands-on science based curriculum focused on biotechnology. Teams were expected to return to their respective counties and teach other youth in 4-H club educational sessions, classroom setting, after-school programs, etc. throughout 2015 and beyond.

BARBARA J. FARIS LEGACY GIFT

In 2014 the Indiana 4-H Foundation was a beneficiary in the estate of Barbara Joan (Plew) Faris from Kosciusko County, who died at 71 after battling breast cancer. Her brothers Al and Bob Plew talked with the Indiana 4-H Foundation about Barbara's incredible life and generous gift.

Barbara was born in Warsaw, Indiana, grew up and stayed in the area. She worked for the public utility company (NIPSCO) for 37 years and was married to Terry L. Faris for 40 years. Terry preceded her in death in 2004. A life-long giver, Barbara served as an EMT on the Pierceton Ambulance Service for 25 years.

She loved to travel for both pleasure and as a missionary. Barbara once hiked to the bottom of the Grand Canyon. As a missionary she traveled across the world including trips to Ethiopia, Cambodia, Haiti, Honduras and Thailand. Prior to her death in 2013, she was planning a trip to Australia, which she was never able to complete. After her death her brother Al and his wife Elaine made the trip to Australia in her memory.

Barbara was never a member of Indiana 4-H, yet she left a very generous legacy gift. Barbara and her husband Terry had a farm and were active in raising registered Polled Hereford Cattle. Many of their steers became 4-H beef projects for kids across northern Indiana and one of Barbara's great joys was following 4-H youth as they showed their cattle in county fairs. Barbara left a lasting impression on many youth in Kosciusko County, not only with the Monroe Merry Maidens 4-H Club, but with other northern Indiana counties and 4-H clubs.

With her generous bequest to the Indiana 4-H Foundation, Barbara continues to inspire youth who are searching for their dreams. A portion of the proceeds have been endowed for the Barbara J. Faris Indiana 4-H Foundation Leadership Scholarship, other funds will support statewide Indiana 4-H programs and Indiana 4-H youth.

ROBERT E. AND MAURINE K. ANDERSON 4-H SCHOLARSHIP

The legacy of Bob and Maurine Anderson will be how much they have given of themselves to so many people.

Bob grew up on a dairy farm in Lafayette and Maurine grew up in town. Bob was a 10 year 4-H member who worked on the family dairy all the way through college. After college Dave Pfendler at Purdue helped Bob with his first job, Purdue 4-H Extension Educator in Marion County, which at the time had more 4-H Club kids than any other county in the country.

Bob moved from Purdue Extension to Equitable Life of New York, where he worked for forty-two years. One of his greatest achievements was Hoosier Life Underwriter of the Year in 1978 – it was such an honor because he received the award from his peers.

While working in the insurance business Bob and Maurine had three daughters who were all 10 year 4-H members. Bob and Maurine spent four years as the Horse and Pony Club leaders. At the time the Horse and Pony Club had 30 kids – 29 were girls. They moved from Indianapolis to Noblesville and acquired a small farm, then to Iron Wheel Farm where they reside today. Bob and Maurine were able to farm on the side throughout their lives. Bob and Maurine still own farm land in three different Indiana counties, though Iron Wheel Farm has been downsized to just a few acres.

Giving back has been the legacy of their life. Together they have delivered Meals on Wheels since it began in Hamilton County forty years ago. Bob also mowed the eight acre yard of his church each week for twenty years and started three different Kiwanis Clubs. Bob has been a member of his current Kiwanis Club for thirty-nine years.

Retired now, but not slowing down, Bob and Maurine continue helping community organizations, volunteering, and spending time with their family. Supporting the Indiana 4-H Foundation is easy “we enjoy supporting organizations that focus on children with a strong interest in doing what is right.”

Life has been really good to us and we try to give it back.
