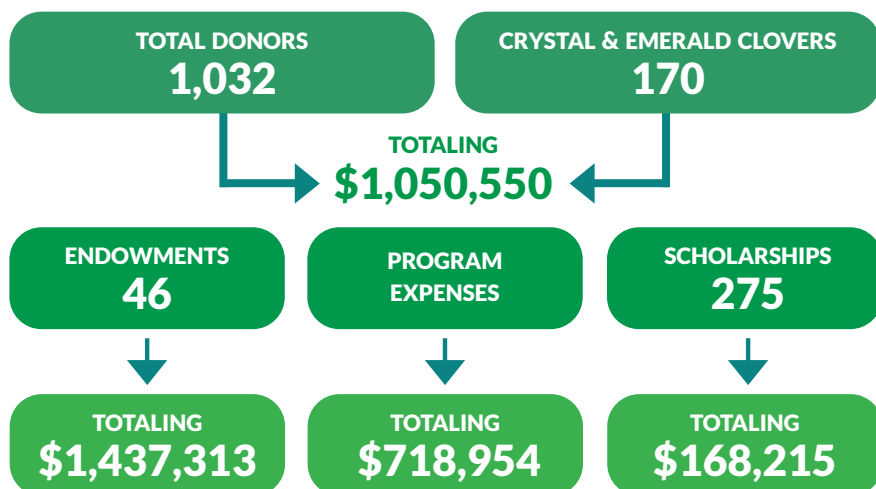
Rewarding 4-H Youth
